1. Meeting opened with a prayer.
2. Devotion: (1 Corinthians 13:12-27)
3. Trustees -
 - a. Gardens: Lynn Lough has been hired to help with the gardens. Funds from Betty and Nodie Alexander memorial are being used. A sign-up sheet to volunteer in the gardens will be passed around in church.
 - b. Backflow valve: The town has new requirements re: Backflow valves. The church has an estimate for \$562 for this work. We already have a backflow valve. Philip Walters will check with the town to see what is needed to be compliant.
 - c. There will be privacy fencing installed in a small corner of the church yard for Rosa. Peter Maki Memorial funds will be used for this project.
 - d. Parsonage: The back-door light is not working. Philip and Cathy Yost will take care of this.

6. WON (worship, Outreach, Nurture)

 - c. Native Grace is in need of funding. Motion was made, seconded and passed to send them \$100/month.
 - d. Hall usage: Discussion re: payment for using the hall, especially if money is being made. Craig will look for old guidelines which may need updating.
 - e. Summer Services: We will have one service at 10:00 starting on May 19th.
 - f. Sanctuary - Discussion about sanctuary as part of the church and the challenge of sharing the space. We have many groups and people with different interests and needs sharing the Fellowship Hall. There is sometimes a conflict between Rosa's wellbeing, privacy, etc. and the needs of the church to be open to all.
7. Pastor:
 - a. Craig will be away on the 19th for Andie's graduation and to help Ro transfer to a new school. Anna Taft will be speaking at the service.
 - b. Annual conference is June 13-16 in Billings, Montana. Craig, Silvia and Andie will be attending to represent our church. One of the issues to be addressed will be the future of the church. Options are:
 - i. Stay with the traditionalists
 - ii. Leave as a solo church.
 - iii. Leave as a conference. This is the option we will choose.
 - c. permission was given for Jennifer to use a room in the parsonage for her cranial sacral work.
